	Agastache (anise hyssop) sun	
T	Agastache foeniculum 'Fragrant Delight' (lavender hyssop) 5' Colorful spikes of lavender flowers are edible, fragrant and good cut. Attracts hummingbirds, bees, butterflies. Rub crushed leaves on skin to repel mosquitos. Use as tea or flavoring.	VL
S	Agastache 'Golden Jubilee' 18-24" Blue flowers over chartreuse-yellow foliage	
S	Agastache pallida 'Globetrotter' 30" Dense spikes of lilac-pink flowers w/reddish bracts June to Sept. Terrific cut flowers. Combines beautifully with Echinacea and Penstemon.	
S	Agastache rupestris 'Apache Sunset' 24" Tubular flowers in rich shades of peach, rose & orange, June to October. Excellent for cutting. Silver-gray, lacy foliage, provides striking contrast. Whole plant emits wonderful root beer-like fragrance.

T	Ajuga pyramidalis 'Metallica Crispa' 4-6" Deep bronze-purple foliage w/metallic appearance that looks nice all year especially in sun. Short spikes of blue flowers in spring is stunning. Evergreen groundcover that can grow where grass is hard to establish. Not invasive.	
	Allium (ornamental onion) sun + well drained soil	
	Allium General: Drought tolerant. Very easy to grow, carefree, needs a dry location. Showy in mass. Flowers can be dried by standing upright in a container without water. Blossoms tower above foliage. Deer proof.	
T	Allium hollandicum 'Purple Sensation' 2' Large purple sphere blossoms on 3' stems, let self seed after 1st year. Summer dormant so inter-plant with perennials.	
T, L	Allium senescens 1' Bright green flat foliage. 3" lavender-pink umbels on 20" stems in July-Aug. Drought tolerant.	
	Armeria (sea pink) sun + well drained soil	
T	Armeria maritima 'Splendens' 6-8" Charming globe-shaped flowers in shades of pink. Low foliage looks good all season long.	N
	Anemone (Japanese windflower) pt.shade	
T	Anemone hupehensis 'September Charm' 2-3' Abundant silvery pink flowers late summer-fall. Attractive foliage. Valued for late season bloom.	L
S	Anemone sylvestris (snowdrop) 15-18" Fragrant. Gently nodding 2" cup shaped pure white flowers in late spring.	N
	Aquilegia (columbine) sun to shade	
	Aquilegia General: There are many forms of this wonderful flower: some form a delicate star of outer petals surrounding an inner ring with yellow centers - some have long spurs that project out behind the blossoms - others are spurless with double blossoms. All are graceful, with blue-green foliage. Aquilegia is easy to grow in loose, average to rich, well-drained soil. Self sows without being	

T, F	Aquilegia misc. (Anything Goes) 2' Graceful, pendulous flowers of mixed colors, compact mounding bluish green foliage, easy care, reseeds. A wealth of flowers in sun or shade	
Arisaema (Jack in the Pulpit) pt.shade/shade		
F	Arisaema dracontium (green dragon) 1'-3' Aroid with whorled green leaves, greenish flower spike (similar to Jack in the Pulpit)	N
T	Arisaema sikokianum (Japanese cobra lily) 20-30" A burgundy "horn" pops out of ground early spring revealing chocolate-purple & verticle white inner striping, & snow-white spadix. Seedheads look like small cobs of popcorn starting out green, ripening to yellow and then bright orange-red.	N
T, F, L	Arisaema triphyllum 18-24" Hooded bloom, striped in green, brown and white; scarlet-orange fruit in fall.	V
Aruncus (goatsbeard) pt.shade/shade		
T, L	Aruncus aethusifolius 18" Dwarf variety. Fern-like leaves, it resembles astilbe, but more contained & compact. White flowers in summer.	V
F	Aruncus dioicus 2' Native. Fluffy white flower plumes to 6', resembles a giant astilbe with fern-like foliage. Tough as nails.	V
Asarum (ginger) (groundcover) pt.shade/shade		
T, S	Asarum europaeum 3" Glossy green kidney-shaped foliage; elegant groundcover for shade. Easy, carefree.	
Asclepias (milkweed) sun/pt.shade		
F, p	Asclepias tuberosa 12"-24" Clusters of yellow or orange flowers in summer, host and nectar plant for butterflies. Full sun.	V
Aster (Michaelmas daisies) sun/pt.shade		
	Aster General: Asters are invaluable in the hardy border, adding superb color in the autumn. Very durable and long lived. Even heavy, wet soils will suit them. Mounds of color beginning in September, in a full range of colors. Pinch back before July for best display.	
F	Aster divaricatus (white wood aster) 2-3' Clouds of small white daisy-like flowers in September and October over dark green foliage. Good for dry shade.	V
Astilbe (false spiraea / plume flower) pt.shade/shade		
	Astilbe General: Attractive delicate fern-like foliage with showy frothy plumes midsummer in shades of pink, peach, white, rose, red. Lush deeply cut foliage is attractive for the entire season and is colored from green to bronze. Prefers rich moist soil. Can take sun if well watered. Deer resistant.	
L	Astilbe chinensis v. pumila 10" Dwarf variety with red-green leaves. Great used as groundcover. Striking plume-like flowers of reddish pink	
L, M	Astilbe hybrids misc. 2-3' Long lasting feathery plumes in summer, fern like foliage. Bright pink, pale pink, or peach. Wispy bright coral pink blooms early July. Rose lilac blooms early July.

A	Phyllostachys aureosulcata (yellow groove bamboo) 15-25' Evergreen bamboo. China native. Invasive if not maintained within bounds.	
A	Shibataea kumasaca 4'-5' Beautiful small evergreen clumping/running bamboo; acid soil.	
Baptisia (false indigo) sun/pt.shade		
M	Baptisia australis 3-4' 2010 PPA Plant of the Year. Spikes of 12" blue lupine-like blooms, long lived & carefree. Bushy clump of blue-green foliage, good cut foliage & flowers, attractive seed pods for crafting.	V
T	Baptisia lactea 2-4' (white wild indigo) Statuesque in form, with blue-gray foliage. Loose spike-like racemes to 18" of white 1" pea-shaped flowers. Attracts butterflies. Inflated 2.5" seed pods turn charcoal black & have considerable interest.	V

F	Belamcanda 2'-3' Speckled orange or yellow flowers, tall stems, iris like foliage, summer	
Brunnera (Siberian bugloss) pt.shade – moist soil		
F	Brunnera macrophylla 12-18" Lovely shade perennial, sky blue flowers in April/May. Resembles a giant forget-me-not! Resents dry soil.	
Campanula (bellflower) sun/pt.shade		

	<u>Campaula General:</u> Campanulas are marvelous and one of our favorites! A large genus from low growing to tall stately specimens. Mostly blue or purple, but also white, pink, rose, lavender flowers. Long lived, easy care.	
F	Campanula glomerata 'Joan Elliott' 18" Double purple flowers, mid summer	
T	Campanula punctata misc. (var? 'Hot Lips') 12" Vigorous grower with 2" tubular white bellflowers speckled inside with burgundy-pink. Excellent spreading groundcover and great for rock garden.	
	Centaurea (cornflower) sun/pt.shade	
L	Centaurea montana 2' Violet blue showy fringed flowers, lance-like silvery green foliage, cut back after flowering for rebloom	
	Chrysanthemum (garden mums) sun/pt.shade	
T	Chrysanthemum koreana 'Sheffield' (aka Dendranthema rubellum) 30" Salmony pink yellow-eyed daisy flowers in abundance, very long flowering. A beautiful mound of color in late season.	
M	Chrysanthemum nipponicum (Montauk daisy) 2-3' White flowers late summer/fall	
F	Chrysanthemum 'Venus' 2' Pale pinkish white flowers, deep green foliage, fall bloomer.	N

	Convallaria (lily of the valley) pt.shade/shade	
A	Convallaria majalis rosea Z. 4 Fragrant pink flowers, May. Rare. Spreads very slowly	
	Coreopsis (tickseed) sun/pt.shade	
F	Coreopsis tripteris 5-6' Statuesque with 2" butter yellow daisies in July and September. Birds love the seeds. Deer resistant. Native.	V
	Corydalis (cordyalis) sun to shade	
T, P	Corydalis lutea 8-12" Delicate leafy foliage, free flowering from May to September, cheery yellow flowers. Prefers rich, moist soils that don't dry out in summer but not wet in winter.	
	Cryptotaenia (Japanese parsley) sun/pt.shade	
T	Cryptotaenia japonica atropurpurea 26" Attractive chocolate colored maple-like foliage, tiny pale pink flowers, nice for color contrast in borders. Self seeds.	
	Dianthus (pinks) sun + well drained soil	
S	Dianthus deltoides 'Arctic Fire' 6-10" White petals with a red eye. Low grey leaved plants.	
S	Dianthus deltoides 'Zing Rose' 6-9" Bright rose-red flowers over a mounding clump of bright green leaves	
	Dicentra (bleeding heart) pt.shade/shade	
P, S	Dicentra canadensis 12" Native, fern-leaved with pink heart-shaped flowers	V
S, P, M	Dicentra spectabilis misc. 2-3' Sprays of pendant, heart-shaped flowers above fern-like foliage in spring. Showy deep rose or white. Summer dormant.	
	Digitalis (foxglove) sun/pt.shade	
T	Digitalis lutea (perennial) 3' A different species to traditional cultivated foxglove, with delicate small creamy yellow tubular flowers on slender stalks. Simple elegance. Glossy green, narrow-leaved foliage. Reliably perennial.	
S	Digitalis purpurea 'Foxy' 1-3' Enormous spires of large, dangling bells in soft pastel shades from cream to pink and rose in spring. Low rosette of coarse, hairy leaves - compact selection. Reseeds freely.	
	Doronicum (leopard's bane) sun/pt.shade	
T	Doronicum caucasicum 'Little Leo' 12" An herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped leaves and golden, daisy-like, semi-double flowers in spring. Dislikes dry soils.	
	Echinacea (coneflower) sun/pt.shade	
	<u>Echinacea General:</u> One of the best border plants. Flower petals radiate downward from a pronounced central seed head. Excellent cut flower, attractive to butterflies. Easy to grow. Flowers from July to frost.	
M	Echinacea 'Green Jewel' 3' Bright green petals, darker green cone	
M	Echinacea 'Harvest Moon' 2.5' Golden yellow with orange center cone	
M	Echinacea 'Hot Papaya' 3' Double orange/red flowers	
M	Echinacea 'Marmalade' 32" Orange poodle-like top with banana yellow petals falling straight down	

M	Echinacea 'Milkshake' 3' Large double white pompom flowers

Epimedium (barrenwort / bishop's hat) pt.shade/shade		
<u>Epimedium General:</u> A terrific woodland plant that fills in under trees and in dry shade! Spring blooming with orchid-like flowers in many colors. Pest free. Evergreen colorful foliage can be cut back early spring before flowering. Resilient & tough.		
L, M, D	Epimedium rubrum 8-12" Bright crimson and cream white flowers, spring bloom. Pointed, heart-shaped leaflets on wiry stems, new growth has reddish tinge, reddish fall color.	
T, P	Epimedium warleyense 'Orange Queen' 18" Bushy, evergreen mound, bearing sprays of coppery-orange flowers mid to late spring. Long-lived. Drought tolerant once established. Green foliage with a light bronze edge holds color through fall.	N
P, F	Epimedium misc. Delicate sprays of yellow, white, or purple early spring flowers. Lush, heart shaped foliage, semi-evergreen groundcover, drought tolerant when established.

M	Euphorbia 'Excalibur' 2.5-3' Outstanding red foliage in spring, grey green leaves with white veins and red edge, purplish red in fall.	N
S	Euphorbia polychroma 'Bonfire' 12" Red foliage on neat clumps with yellow flowers appearing to be spray painted on contrasting foliage	N
FERNS pt.shade/shade		
T, D	Athyrium niponicum 'Pictum' (Japanese painted fern) 16" <u>2004 Perennial Plant of the Year!</u> A showy combination of colorful fronds of grey-green blended with wine red. Lacy leaves are wide and taper to a delicate point. Deer resistant.	
T, P	Dryopteris erythrosora 'Brilliance' (autumn fern) 18-30" Colorful groundcover with pink fiddleheads that turn coppery orange as they unfurl. Ages to lustrous dark green & remain well into winter. New growth gives colorful tapestry effect spring to late fall.	N
D	Dryopteris filix-mas (male fern) 3' Upright habit, lance-shaped 2 pinnate fronds. Moist, fertile, acidic soil. A grand statement in the woodland garden.	
S	Matteuccia struthiopteris 'Ostrich Fern' (fiddlehead fern) 3-6' Green fronds are shaped like ostrich plumes. Dramatic. Spreads. Needs moist soil. Harvest fiddleheads in spring to eat.	
D	Polystichum acrostichoides 'Christmas Fern' 2' Fountain-like clump w/leathery, lance-shaped, evergreen fronds	
Filipendula (meadowsweet) sun/shade		
T	Filipendula palmata misc. 4' Victorian looking foamy sprays of creamy pinkish white, late June. Attractive palmate foliage. Easy care.	
T	Filipendula misc. 1-3' Victorian looking foamy sprays of creamy white or pinkish white, late June. Attractive palmate foliage. Easy care.	
Galium (sweet woodruff)		
S	Galium odoratum (sweet woodruff) 6" Ground cover for partially shaded, moist areas. Tiny, white, star-shaped flowers appear in late spring above a carpet of green foliage. Good to hide dying bulb foliage. Fragrant leaves are used dried for May wine.	
Geranium (cranesbill) sun/pt.shade		
<u>Geranium General:</u> Easy to grow, dense mound attractive foliage, masses of flowers. Cut back taller varieties after first bloom to renew foliage and encourage rebloom.		
T	Geranium macrorrhizum 'Iverson's' 12-18" Light pink flowers w/darker sepals & stems are held high above wonderfully fragrant foliage. Lovely fragrant foliage. Tolerates bright shade & drier soils. Reblooms.	

S	Geranium sanguineum striatum 8-12" Carmine-rose 1" flowers. June bloom with excellent rebloom all summer. Foliage is low mounding with small deeply divided leaves. Use as edging.	
T, F	Geranium misc. 12-18" Dark pink, magenta, white or carmine rose flowers.	
GRASSES & GRASS-LIKE PLANTS		
	Note: Grasses make a marvelous addition to a perennial border and add much desired fall interest as well as structural form. Plumes or seed heads as well as grass blades can be used in flower or dried arrangements. They are long-lived, sustainable, easy to grow. Grasses below are clumping unless otherwise noted.	
T	Chasmanthum latifolium 'Northern Sea Oats' 3' pt.shade Interesting flat oat-like tan seed fronds on arching panicles in fall, excellent winter interest and good dried. A great grass!	V
S	Ophiopogon japonicus 'Variegata' (mondo grass) 12-15" sun/pt.shade Variegated, slowly spreading, lance leaved grass-like plant which brightens up even the shadiest spot	N
F	Panicum virgatum 'Heavy Metal' (switch grass) 4' sun/pt.shade Blue-green leaves, pinkish colored plumes in fall, good cut. Nice in perennial beds.	V
Helleborus (lenten rose, hellebore) pt.shade/shade		
	Helleborus General: One of our favorites! WC137:C185rs of cup shaped flowers. Earliest perennial to bloom in late winter. Float flowers in bowl of water. Good beneath deciduous trees. Deer resistant & slug proof.	
T, P	Helleborus 'Double Queen Strain' 12-15" Beautiful range of double flowers in white, yellows, burgundies, pinks, greens & apricots, some with spots. Note: This strain is purported to offer close to 100% double flowers.	
T, F	Helleborus foetidus 2-3' Truly blooms in winter with awesome clusters of green flowers. Deeply palmate leaves. Blooms forever.	
P	Helleborus 'Ivory Prince' 12-18" Rich burgundy pink buds open to outward facing ivory white blossoms which become streaked with rose and chartreuse as they age. Attractive dark blue-green distinctively veined and toothed foliage remains compact. A showy, long blooming favorite!	
T, P	Helleborus orientalis 'Mango Magic' 20" A brand-new color for the family: 3" blooms w/creamy orange-apricot tones with red flecks and edges. Flowers remain for 3 months or more, drying to an exquisite papery consistency. At maturity can sport 50+ flowers.	N
T, P, F	Helleborus orientalis misc. 2' Long-lasting 1-2" nodding cup shaped flowers in clusters, unique colors ranging from white to pink to mauve to maroon, patterns ranging from speckled to streaked to shaded.

	Hemerocallis General: Indestructible perennials for full sun, showy flowers, low maintenance. Plant early to late bloomers for long season coverage. Easy to grow!
