	Achillea (yarrow) sun + well drained soil	
T	Achillea millifolium misc. 2' Clusters of pink blooms atop silver-grey lacy foliage. Drought tolerant.	
F	Achillea millifolium Appleblossom 2' Pale pink flowers, lacy foliage.	
	Actaea (bugbane / baneberry) sun/pt.shade (reclassified from Cimicifuga)	
T,F	Actaea (cimicifuga) racemosa 4'-6' Slender spires of white flowers late summer over dark foliage.	
	Agastache (anise hyssop) sun	
T,F	Agastache foeniculum 2-3' Violet blue spikes of flowers, minty foliage, attracts butterflies	
	Ajuga (bugleweed) sun to shade	
T	Ajuga pyramidalis 'Metallica Crispa' 4-6" Deep bronze-purple foliage w/metallic appearance that looks nice all year especially in sun. Stunning short spikes of blue flowers in spring. Evergreen groundcover that can grow where grass is hard to establish. Not invasive.	
	Alchemilla (lady's mantle) sun/pt.shade	
T	Alchemilla mollis 10-16" Handsome edger. Sprays of chartreuse flowers in July, splendid fan shaped pleated foliage that collect dew drops as sparkling jewels. Good cut flowers.	
	Allium (ornamental onion) sun + well drained soil	
	<u>Allium General:</u> Drought tolerant. Very easy to grow, carefree, needs a dry location. Showy in mass. Flowers can be dried by standing upright in a container without water. Blossoms tower above foliage. Deer proof.	
T	Allium albopilosum, christophii (Star of Persia) 18-22" Excellent cut flower either living or dried. Stunning w/very dense stary amethyst-violet flowers in each of its 8-10" blooms.	N
T	Allium hollandicum 'Purple Sensation' 2' Large purple sphere blossoms on 3' stems, let self seed after 1st year. Summer dormant so inter-plant with perennials.	
T	Allium senescens 1' Bright green flat foliage. 3" lavender-pink umbels on 20" stems in July-Aug. Drought tolerant.	
	Anemone (Japanese windflower) pt.shade	
T	Anemone blanda 'Blue Shades' 4-6" Single, daisy-shaped flowers in blues. When happy where planted, it naturalizes by bulb offsets into a carpet. Terrific in garden & sunny woodland borders.	N
T	Anemone Fantasy 'Pocahontas' 12-18" sun Double flowered, bubblegum pink blooms from July-Sept. Vigorous, filling in quickly. Fluffy, creamy white, cotton-like seed heads extend interest into late fall.	N
T	Anemone hupehensis 'Pretty Lady Maria' 12-16" Single, white blooms over 2" appear August to November. Compact, long-lived plants have attractive dark green foliage.	N
T	Anemone sylvestris (snowdrop) 15-18" Fragrant. Gently nodding 2" cup-shaped pure white flowers in late spring. Deer and rabbit-resistant.	N

T	Anemone 'Wild Swan' 20" This rupicola hybrid blooms late spring to frost with continuous prolific bloom. Huge 3-3.5" white flowers with lilac-blue bands on the backside.	N
	Anthriscus (Lady Anne's lace) sun	
T	Anthriscus sylvestris 'Ravenswing' 1-3' Bronze purple form of Queen Anne's lace w/ fringed dusky purple foliage. Cut off flower stalks to prevent reseeding and prolong foliage vigor.	
	Aquilegia (columbine) sun to shade	
	<u>Aquilegia General:</u> There are many forms of this wonderful flower: some form a delicate star of outer petals surrounding an inner ring with yellow centers - some have long spurs that project out behind the blossoms - others are spurless with double blossoms. All are graceful, with blue-green foliage. Easy to grow in loose, average to rich, well-drained soil. Self sows without being annoying.	
T	Aquilegia 'Blazing Star' 2-3' Heat tolerant columbine with red and yellow flowers that are good for cutting. Attractive to bees, butterflies & birds.	N
T, F	Aquilegia misc. (Anything Goes) 2' Graceful, pendulous flowers of mixed colors, compact mounding bluish green foliage, easy care, reseeds. A wealth of flowers in sun or shade.	
	Arisaema (Jack in the Pulpit) pt.shade/shade	
F	Arisaema dracontium (green dragon) 1'-3' Aroid with whorled green leaves, greenish flower spike (similar to Jack in the Pulpit)	
	Aruncus (goatsbeard) pt.shade/shade	
F	Aruncus dioicus 2' Native. Fluffy white flower plumes to 6', resembles a giant astilbe with fern-like foliage. Tough as nails.	V
	Asarum (ginger) (groundcover) pt.shade/shade	
T	Asarum europaeum 3" Glossy green kidney-shaped foliage; elegant groundcover for shade. Easy, carefree.	
	Asclepias (milkweed) sun/pt.shade	
F	Asclepias tuberosa 12"-24" Clusters of yellow or orange flowers in summer, host and nectar plant for butterflies. Full sun.	V
	Aster (Michaelmas daisies) sun/pt.shade	
	<u>Aster General:</u> Asters are invaluable in the hardy border, adding superb color in the autumn. Very durable and long lived. Even heavy, wet soils will suit them. Mounds of color beginning in September, in a full range of colors. Pinch back before July for best display.	
F	Aster divaricatus (white wood aster) 2-3' Clouds of small white daisy-like flowers in September and October over dark green foliage. Good for dry shade.	V
	Astilbe (false spiraea / plume flower) pt.shade/shade	
	<u>Astilbe General:</u> Attractive delicate fern-like foliage with showy frothy plumes midsummer in shades of pink, peach, white, rose, red. Lush deeply cut foliage is attractive for the entire season and is colored from green to bronze. Prefers rich moist soil. Can take sun if well watered. Deer resistant.	
M	Astilbe 'Delft Lace' 2'-3' Light pink blooms early to midsummer, prefers shade.	N
T	Astilbe hybrids misc. 2-3' Long lasting feathery plumes in summer, fern like foliage. Bright pink, pale pink, rose, white or peach. Blooms early July.	
	Baptisia (false indigo) sun/pt.shade	
F	Baptisia australis 3-4' Spikes of 12" blue lupine-like blooms, long lived & carefree. Bushy clump of blue-green foliage, good cut foliage & flowers, attractive seed pods for crafting. 2010 Plant of the Year.	
T	Baptisia 'Purple Smoke' 3'-4' Violet blue lupine-like flower. Smokey purple stems, gray green unique foliage. Vigorous, structural & long lasting.	
	Belamcanda (blackberry lily) sun	
F	Belamcanda 2'-3' Speckled orange or yellow flowers, tall stems, iris like foliage, summer	
	Brunnera (Siberian bugloss) pt.shade - moist soil	
F	Brunnera macrophylla 12-18" Lovely shade perennial, sky blue flowers in April/May. Resembles a giant forget-me-not! Resents dry soil.	
	Camassia (camas lily) sun/pt.shade	

T	Camassia quamash 18-24" Tall stately spires of starry sapphire blue flowers that follow early spring bulbs. Forms dramatic clumps. Summer dormant. Ask us why we call this "The Bridge Flower."	
	Campanula (bellflower) sun/pt.shade	
	<u>Campanula General:</u> Campanulas are marvelous and one of our favorites! A large genus from low growing to tall stately specimens. Mostly blue or purple, but also white, pink, rose, lavender flowers. Long lived, easy care.	
T	Campanula carpatica 'Blue Clips' 8-10" Violet blue cup shaped flowers on mounding plants. Good in borders. Long blooming.	
F	Campanula glomerata 'Joan Elliott' 18" Double purple flowers, mid summer	
T	Campanula poscharskyana 'Blue Waterfall' 8-10" Blue bell-shaped flowers spill over cascading foliage that is stunning at the front of border. Blooms May into June. Excellent for rock walls. Drought tolerant.	N
	Chrysanthemum (garden mums) sun/pt.shade	
F	Chrysanthemum 'Bolero' 2' Hardy mum. Apricot yellow flowers late summer to fall	N
	Cheloni (turtlehead) sun/pt.shade	
T	Chelone 'Hot Lips' 3' Lustrous, deeper green foliage, topped in August and September with vivid pink turtlehead-shaped flowers. Good cut. Thrives in moist woodland conditions.	V
	Coreopsis (tickseed) sun/pt.shade	
F	Coreopsis tripteris 5-6' Statuesque with 2" butter yellow daisies in July and September. Birds love the seeds. Deer resistant.	V
F	Coreopsis verticillata 'Zagreb' 12-18" Golden yellow flowers all summer atop threadlike foliage. Spreads through underground runners. Long blooming.	
	Corydalis (cordyalis) sun to shade	
F	Corydalis lutea 8-12" Delicate leafy foliage, free flowering from May to September, cheery yellow flowers. Prefers rich, moist soils that don't dry out in summer but not wet in winter.	
	Crococsmia sun/pt.shade	
M	Crococsmia crocosmiflora 3' Crescent shaped sprays of fire engine red blooms mid to late summer, sword shaped foliage	N
	Cryptotaenia (Japanese parsley) sun/pt.shade	
T	Cryptotaenia japonica atropurpurea 26" Attractive chocolate colored maple-like foliage, tiny pale pink flowers, nice for color contrast in borders.	
	Dianthus (pinks) sun + well drained soil	
T	Dianthus 'Scent First Sugar Plum' 8-12" Showy, ruffled pink blooms with raspberry eye. Fragrant, semidouble flowers, rise above blue green foliage. Heavy bloomer.	N
	Digitalis (foxglove) sun/pt.shade	
T,F	Digitalis lutea (perennial) 3' A different species to traditional cultivated foxglove, with delicate small creamy yellow tubular flowers on slender stalks. Simple elegance. Glossy green, narrow-leaved foliage. Reliably perennial.	
T	Digitalis purpurea 'Dalmatian Purple' 2-3' Early blooming sturdy rose purple spikes accented with spotted throats. Tends toward biennial so deadhead first year by cutting spent flower stems to base to encourage overwintering. Let seed fall second year to self-sow.	N
	Echinacea (coneflower) sun/pt.shade	
	<u>Echinacea General:</u> One of the best border plants. Flower petals radiate downward from a pronounced central seed head. Excellent cut flower, attractive to butterflies. Easy to grow. Flowers from July to frost.	
M	Echinacea 'Cheyenne Spirit' 1.5-3' Mix of colors, pink, purple, orange, red, yellow white, blooms all summer	N
M	Echinacea 'Golden Skipper' 3' Lemon yellow blooms w brown center, compact sturdy plant blooms all summer	N
M	Echinacea 'Green Jewel' 3' Bright green petals, darker green cone, blooms all summer	N
M	Echinacea 'Magnus' 3' Pink 4" blooms last all summer, drought resistant	N
F	Echinacea paradoxa (Ozark coneflower) 3' Yellow drooping petals, brown cone	
F	Echinacea 'Pink Double Delight' 3' Double pink flowers, long bloom period	

T	Echinacea purpurea 'Pow Wow Wild Berry' 2' Floriferous deep rose-berry blooms with a golden-brown cone that don't fade. Has won numerous honors. Compact plant, great for pots.	
F	Echinacea purpurea 3' Big daisy-like lavender pink blooms on stately plants. Showy! Easy care. Goldfinches love the seedheads. An all-time favorite.	V
	Eupatorium (Joe pye weed) pt.shade	
T	Eupatorium misc. 4-6' pt.shade Common wild flowers which make excellent garden plants. Attracts butterflies. Fluffy pink flower heads late season.	
	Euphorbia (spurge) sun/pt.shade	
T	Euphorbia myrsinites (donkey tail) 6-9" Lime yellow bracts, succulent blue-green leaves spiral around trailing stems, excellent for rock garden, groundcover or stone wall.	
	FERNS pt.shade/shade	
S	Matteuccia struthiopteris 'Ostrich Fern' (fiddlehead fern) 3-6' Green fronds are shaped like ostrich plumes. Dramatic. Spreads. Needs moist soil. Spring fiddleheads are edible.	
	Gaura (wand flower) sun	
T	Gaura lindheimeri 'Whirling Butterflies' 3-4' Vase shaped plant, white flowers dance in a breeze on arching stems, blooms through October, nice in center of border, low basal foliage, hardier than pink variety.	
	Galium (sweet woodruff) pt.shade/shade	
S	Galium odoratum (sweet woodruff) 6" Ground cover for partially shaded, moist areas. Tiny, white, star-shaped flowers appear in late spring above a carpet of green foliage. Good to hide dying bulb foliage. Fragrant leaves are used dried for May wine.	
	Geranium (cranesbill) sun/pt.shade	
	<u>Geranium General:</u> Easy to grow, dense mound attractive foliage, masses of flowers. Cut back taller varieties after first bloom to renew foliage and encourage rebloom.	
T	Geranium renardii 12" Grown for velvet, fuzzy, textured foliage in tidy round clumps; semi-evergreen. Clusters of pale lilac flowers.	
S	Geranium sanguineum 'Striatum'	N
T, F	Geranium sanguineum misc. 8-10" Vivid masses of purple-pink blooms produced all summer over a sprawling mound of deep green, heavily divided foliage. Nice edging.	
	Geum (avens) sun	
T	Geum chiloense 'Red Dragon' 16-20" Long display of frilly double scarlet-red to orange blooms over low mound of coarse green leaves. Deadhead for more blooms. Attractive to butterflies. Easy to grow.	
	GRASSES & GRASS-LIKE PLANTS	
	<u>Note:</u> Grasses make a marvelous addition to a perennial border and add much desired fall interest as well as structural form. Plumes or seed heads as well as grass blades can be used in flower or dried arrangements. They are long-lived, sustainable, easy to grow. Grasses below are clumping unless otherwise noted.	
S	Ophiopogon japonicus 'Variegata' (mondo/monkey grass) 12-15" sun/pt.shade Variegated, slowly spreading, lance leaved grass-like plant which brightens up even the shadiest spot.	
T	Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln' (dwarf fountain grass) 18-30" sun/pt.shade Finely textured rich green foliage, arching coppery tan seed plumes showing into winter. A very popular grass. Good in perennial border.	N
	GROUNDCOVERS	
	See: Ajuga, Asarum, Galium, Heucherella, Lamium, Lysimachia, Omphalodes, Pachysandra, Polygonatum humile, Sedum, Stachys, Tiarella, Vinca, Waldsteinia	
	Gypsophila (baby's breath) sun well-drained soil	
S	Gypsophila repens 'Pixie Splash' 3-5" Showy, early spring perennial displays dainty white blooms with a delicate pink splash. Uniform, compact, and mounded growth habit, excellent for border edging, hanging baskets and containers.	
	Helleborus (lenten rose, hellebore) pt.shade/shade	
	<u>Helleborus General:</u> One of our favorites! Woodland plants with clumps of attractive glossy evergreen leaves and clusters of cup shaped flowers. Earliest perennial to bloom in late winter. Float flowers in bowl of water. Good beneath deciduous trees. Deer resistant & slug proof.	

T	Helleborus foetidus 2-3' Truly blooms in winter with awesome clusters of green flowers. Deeply palmate leaves. Blooms forever.	
F	Helleborus 'Kingston Cardinal' 2' Double flowered dusty rose blooms, April blooming,	
T,P	Helleborus 'Blushing Bridesmaid' (Wedding Party Series) 2' Large numbers of blossoms. . 2-2.5" double white flowers with raspberry pink veining and picotee edge.	N
T,P	Helleborus 'First Dance' (Wedding Party Series) 2' Large numbers of blossoms. 2-2.5" flowers that range from bright yellow to yellow with a maroon picotee edge and veining.	N
T,P	Helleborus 'True Love' (Wedding Party Series) 2' Large numbers of blossoms. 3-3.5" Rich maroon red, double flowers.	N
T,P,F	Helleborus orientalis misc. 2' Long-lasting 1-2" nodding cup shaped flowers in clusters, unique colors ranging from white to pink to mauve to maroon, patterns ranging from speckled to streaked to shaded.	
	Heemerocallis (daylily) sun	
	<u>Heemerocallis General:</u> Indestructible perennials for full sun, showy flowers, low maintenance. Plant early to late bloomers for long season coverage. Easy to grow!	
F	Heemerocallis 'Catherine Woodbury' 3' Pink 6" flowers	
F	Heemerocallis 'Chicago Silver' 2'-3' Dark purple flowers with a pale silvery edge	
F	Heemerocallis 'Cisty' 2.5' Peachy pink, 6" flowers	
F	Heemerocallis 'Crazy Lace' 30" Near white with streaks of pink, yellow	
F	Heemerocallis 'Daveo Holman' 2' Huge 9"-10" flowers, pinkish blend, cream throat	
F	Heemerocallis 'Decatur Jewel' 2' Pinkish lavender, 4" flowers	
F	Heemerocallis 'Easter Holiday' 27" Huge 7" yellow flowers with a green throat	
F	Heemerocallis 'Hyperion' 40" 5" canary yellow trumpet shaped flowers, fragrant	
F	Heemerocallis 'Infinity' 2'-3' Coral pink, double 5.5" flowers	
F	Heemerocallis Jung 'Lemon Ice' 30" Very pale yellow	N
F	Heemerocallis 'Little Fay' 15" Pink, 3.5" flowers	N
F	Heemerocallis 'Margaret Seawright' 2' Ruffled orange and yellow bitone, 4.5" flowers	N
F	Heemerocallis 'Monster' 2'-3' Absolutely enormous yellow spider type flowers!	
F	Heemerocallis 'Orchid Corsage' 3' Spider type lavender cream, 7.5" flowers	N

F	Heemerocallis 'Pennys Worth' 10" True miniature, 1.5" yellow flowers, extra early bloom	N

F	Heemerocallis 'South Seas' 30" 5.5" Tangerine coral flower with a red coral band above yellow green throat. Midseason.	
F	Heemerocallis Spacecoast 'Cranberry Breeze' 2' Dark cranberry, ruffled gold edge, 5" flowers	N
F	Heemerocallis 'Stella in Yella' 15" Short, true yellow flowers, reblooms	
	Heuchera (coral bells) sun to shade	
F	Heuchera 'Citronelle' 12" Chartreuse yellow leaves, small white flowers, no sun	
F	Heuchera 'Crimson Curls' 8-18" Ruffled and curled bronzy-brown foliage. Sprays of small creamy-white flowers late spring and summer.	N
F	Heuchera 'Frosted Violet' 10-12" Wide clumping w/broad leaves deep maroon purple to plum w/darker veining that appear frosted. 30" flower scapes lined w/dainty flowers that look like pink seed pearls.	
T	Heuchera Heukera 'Amber Lady' 6-8" Beautiful amber leaves with pink underside and silver hue. A great container plant.	N
T	Heuchera Heukera 'Sweet Princess' 6-8" Very attractive silver-bronze-peach foliage. Large lobed leaves emerge light apricot, then darken with age to velvety rose. Great container plant.	N
T	Heuchera villosa 'Carnival Peach Parfait' 10-12" Tidy mounding habit. Eye-catching, slightly ruffled peachy foliage touched by deep orange veining and silver highlights	N
	Heucherella (foamy bells) (groundcover) pt.shade/shade	

T	Heucherella 'Buttered Rum' 7" Warm coppery tones, glossy rounded maple leaf shaped foliage. Cool weather brings rose red transformation. White flower sprays in early summer. Spills nicely over the edges of a container.	N
	Hibiscus (rose mallow) sun	
T	Hibiscus moscheutos 'Luna Pink Swirl' 2-3' Showy 8" blooms have dark cranberry centers. Petals fade from light creamy pink to pink, creating a swirl effect over compact foliage with a full, bushy habit. Late breaking dormancy.	NV
F	Hibiscus moscheutos misc. 4'-5' Tall, late blooming perennials with pink to white flowers, slow to break dormancy.	V
	Hosta (plaintain lily) pt.shade/shade	
A	Hosta named hybrids 2-8" A collection of 20+ named miniature & dwarf varieties. Suitable for container gardens.	
D	Hosta 'Abba Dabba Do' 3-4'x5' 9x14" leaves start out all green and quickly develop a bright yellow contrasting edge, slightly rippled, vigorous.	
D	Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears' 4-6"H Thick blue-green spoon-shaped leaves, a must-have miniature gem!	
T,P	Hosta 'Bridal Falls' 26-28" Rounded mound of cascading green leaves with pale yellow to creamy white margins. Heart-shaped leaves are edged in pie crust waves & have deeply impressed veins.	
D	Hosta 'Emerald Tiara' 14"x24" Low, dense mound of gold-centered, green-margined foliage; a vigorous grower.	
D	Hosta 'Francee' Medium, variegated w/white edge	
D	Hosta 'Golden Tiara' 8-10"H Small, heart-shaped, green leaves w/wide chartreuse margins, become gold in sun.	
T	Hosta 'Laviegata' 10" A delightful new "species." Stiff, narrow, wavy and glossy green leaves make a distinctive, upright, vase-shaped, 15" wide clump. Has "spider-like" dark lavender flowers.	N
D	Hosta 'Leola Fraim' 11"x17" Medium to dark green w/white margin that varies in width, but wider near the tip. 8"x 6" leaves are cupped. A strong grower.	
T	Hosta 'Marginato-Alba' 18"x3' Deep green with cream edge, 5.5x9" leaf	
D	Hosta 'Montana Aureomarginata' 27"x4' Huge 12"x8" substantive, dark green leaves with wide, irregular, gold margins that hold their color all season long	
D	Hosta 'Night Before Christmas' 18"x36" Huge, dark green leaves have striking creamy-white centers that change to pure white by midsummer	
D	Hosta 'Patriot' 22"x30" Ovate leaves, dark green centers & outstanding, crisp white, streaked margins (creamy-yellow in spring) & slightly wavy. Good sun tolerance.	
D	Hosta 'Sagae' 28x24" Stunning, huge, thick, nearly triangular leaves are frosted blue-green with wavy, yellow margins which turn creamy-white, grey-green streak.	
D	Hosta 'Spilt Milk' Large, variegated	
T	Hosta 'Striptease' 16-20" <u>2005 Hosta of the Year!</u> Wide dark green margin, bright chartreuse center, narrow white band separates variegation when mature, medium-size mound.	
D	Hosta 'Summer Love' 16 x 30 Very wide gold edge	N
D	Hosta tokadama 'Aureonebulosa' 15"x32" Very puckered leaf streaked, blue-green margins and chartreuse centers which turn gold by midsummer	N
D	Hosta tokadama 'Flavocircinalis' 17"x48" Very puckered leaf, nearly round, slightly cupped, 9"L, corrugated leaves have blue-green centers which change to dark green by midsummer	N
D	Hosta 'Wide Brim' 16" Nicely mounded leaves are dark green with wide, irregular margins of buttery yellow	
D	Hosta 'Wolverine' 18x40" Medium, variegated w/cream edge. Very fast grower. Real beauty.	
	Iberis (candytuft) sun	
S	Iberis sempervirens 'Snowflake' 8-10" Cascade over rocks & walls, or groundcover. Glossy, evergreen foliage forms compact mound w/loads of white flowers for several weeks, prune lightly right after blooming.	
	Iris Germanica (bearded iris) sun	

F	Iris germanica 'Anaconda Love' 24" Dramatic, pink standards, purple/white streaked falls	N
F	Iris germanica 'Clarence' 35" Pale blue and cream blooms in May	N
F	Iris germanica 'Harvest of Memories' 38" Big bright yellow blooms in May	N
F	Iris germanica misc. 8" Mini, purple flowers in May, plant shallowly	
F	Iris germanica misc. 8" Mini, dark maroon red, blooms in May	
F	Iris germanica misc. Two-tone pink and purple flowers in May.
